

Collage Assignment

This assignment will allow you to introduce yourself to the Linked class, help us get a sense of who you are, and start the year off with something creative.

Consider some aspects of your personality and yourself that you want to share. Then, create a collage that depicts these aspects of your personality, interests, values. To make your collage:

- 1) Begin with a **photo of yourself** in the center of **8½ x 11"** sheet of either white paper or colored construction paper.
- 2) Use **personal artifacts**, headlines and clippings from newspapers, magazines, photos, advertisements, cartoons, and other sources you think appropriate and paste them onto your paper.
- 3) Type a **key**—with your name and block on top—with brief explanations what each picture reveals about you; attach it to the back of your collage. Number the front of each picture to correspond with the numbers on the key.
- 4) Be prepared to **share your collage** with the class and the collages will be posted in the room for the year . . . so make your collage presentable! 😊

** Please avoid including valuable items on your collage. A photograph or facsimile is perfectly fine.*
