



## Windows & Mirrors

## **Global History & English Assignment**

Our study of both English and history can serve as a window into other customs, attitudes, and beliefs and simultaneously mirror back our own customs, attitudes, and beliefs. Each Tuesday, we will ask two students to present briefly on how an element of our current curriculum serves as both a window and a mirror for them.

## Requirements are as follows:

- 1. What in our current study of literature or history serves as a window and/or mirror for you? Choose one window example and one mirror example and explain in 200-300 words why they are such. Type and submit the paragraphs to Mr. Golding on Turnitin.com.
- 2. Choose an image for each example that will help the class understand the connections you have made. Email the images (in a PowerPoint, if possible) or bring them in on a flash drive.
- 3. Prepare to share your observations with the classes in a two to three minute presentation during which you will project your images and explain your "window" and your "mirror." You may not read from your paragraph, but you may use note cards.
